The Community Foundation of West Texas, formerly known as the Lubbock Area Foundation is an independent, non-profit, publicly supported, tax-exempt organization founded in 1981 to help donors meet the existing and future needs of the area's educational, health, cultural, civic and charitable organizations. The Foundation's scope goes beyond social service and welfare; our donors are improving the overall quality of life in the South Plains area.

The Community Foundation of West Texas administers a variety of charitable funds. Recognizing the importance of scholarships, especially with decreasing dollars for education at the federal level and increasing educational costs for students, the Foundation is pleased to administer the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund, which is described below.

The Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund

Founded in 1951, the Lubbock Art Association was a community based visual arts organization that played an active role in promoting the fine arts and art education in the South Plains region until its dissolution in 2003. In furthering the Association's efforts to strengthen the importance of the fine arts in this region for artists and art lovers, the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund awards are made to talented young artists so they may continue their art education at the post-secondary level.

Eligibility Requirements:

Without discrimination toward race or sex, the following eligibility requirements shall apply to candidates for the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship:

- 1. Student must be a graduating senior of a Lubbock County high school.
- 2. Student must have high school credits in advanced art courses.
- 3. Student must be planning to continue their education in an arts related field.
- 4. The scholarship advisory committee or Foundation staff may interview student.

Selection Process:

1. All scholarship applications must be completed in full and submitted to the Community Foundation of West Texas (6102 82nd Street 8B, Lubbock TX 79414) no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 24, 2017.

- 2. Artwork must be hand delivered (ready to hang/display) to the Tornado Gallery (1822 Buddy Holly Avenue) by 2:00pm on Friday, March 24, 2017. The artwork will be a part of the First Friday Art Trail for the month of April! Artwork will be displayed at the Tornado Gallery until April 22nd. After that time it is your responsibility to pick up the artwork from Tornado Gallery.
- 3. The Scholarship Advisory Committee will view artwork and review completed applications and make recommendations for scholarship awards to the Community Foundation of West Texas Board of Directors. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 4. The Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of West Texas will review the recommendations of the Scholarship Advisory Committee and make final decisions by May 1st.

Scholarship Fund Disbursement:

- 1. An annual one-time award will be made prior to the beginning of the Fall semester.
- Scholarship payments will be made directly to the school in which the student is enrolling
 and may be used for tuition, fees and books only. Any funds remaining at the end of the year
 for which the scholarship was intended must be returned to the Community Foundation of
 West Texas.

Application Procedures:

In addition to the application, the following is required:

- 1. Up to three original works must be submitted for showing at the Tornado Gallery (1822 Buddy Holly Avenue) on March 29th. <u>Please place your full name and name of artwork on the back of your art pieces</u> (matching what is on your application). If you are interested in selling your artwork, please place sale price on the back of the artwork.
- 2. Letter of recommendation from an art teacher who has instructed you.
- 3. High School transcript
- 4. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the applicant's college or university should be submitted with the application if possible, or immediately upon receipt of such acceptance.
- 5. The applicant should complete the application by typing or printing all answers.
- 6. The application must be completed in full and submitted by March 24, 2017 to the Community Foundation of West Texas.
- 7. Applications that are not complete will not be eligible for consideration.
