Eligibility Requirements:

Without discrimination toward race or sex, the following eligibility requirements shall apply to candidates for the Winfred & Ellen Tucker Scholarship:

- ❖ Graduating Senior at Meadow High School
- ❖ Pursuing post-secondary education in Viticulture and/or Agriculture
- ❖ Have 2.5 GPA or higher
- ❖ Financial need may be considered
- ❖ Intent to enroll as a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours) at an accredited college, university or technical school during the fall semester following graduation from high school with the intent of receiving a degree.

Selection Process:

- ❖ The Scholarship Advisory Committee will consist of a family member of the Tucker family, Mrs. Kim Bayer, the Senior Counselor of Meadow High School, a community representative, and the Agriculture Teacher of Meadow High School.
- ❖ The Scholarship Advisory Committee will review completed applications and make recommendations to the Community Foundation of West Texas Board of Directors, which will make the final decision on the scholarship awards.
- ❖ Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- ❖ The recipient will be announced by April 15.

Scholarship Fund Disbursement:

- ❖ Scholarships will be awarded based on the availability of funds, and may be used for tuition, fees and required books.
- ❖ Scholarships will be paid to the school, and not directly to the recipient.
- ❖ All unused funds must be returned to the Community Foundation of West Texas.

Application Requirements:

All scholarship applications must be completed in full and submitted by **March 15**.
